

Patient Information: Reassessment appointment

This appointment is designed to retest your hearing and ensure that you have hearing aids that are sufficient for your needs.

How long will the appointment be?

30-40 minutes

What to expect during the appointment

At the start of the appointment, the Audiologist will ask you questions regarding the difficulties you are facing with your hearing. They will also ask you about your general health and any other relevant history regarding your symptoms.

The audiologist will conduct a hearing test and then program hearing aids to match your test results. The audiologist may re-program your current aids, or fit new aids depending on your needs.

Preparation guidelines

If you have significant wax in your ears there is a possibility that we will be unable to complete the appointment.

Test that may be carried out:

- The Audiologist will look in your ears.
- A hearing test will be carried out using several different types of headset.
- A pressure test checking the function of the middle ear may be performed if your audiologist feels that it is necessary.
- Hearing aid sound check - the audiologist may put some fine tubes into your ears along with your hearing aids, and play a variety of sounds to check your hearing aid prescription.
