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Workshop Objectives:

- By the end of this workshop care home staff:
- Will be able to list the signs and symptoms of a stroke, identify risk factors, and describe the FAST (Face, Arms, Speech, Time) method for stroke emergencies.
- Be able to explain communication disorders post stroke, its impacts and demonstrate effective communication strategies to use with stroke survivors.
- Understand the impacts of Dysphagia (swallowing difficulties), treatments and show improved understanding and empathy when assisting individuals post stroke.
- Understand the importance of good nutrition for stroke survivors
- Be able to identify cognitive effects of stroke and strategies to support individuals.
- Have improved confidence supporting stroke survivors, by demonstrating improved manual handling awareness of stroke survivors when transferring, in bed or when seated.
- Demonstrate empathy towards stroke survivors by exploring the impacts of stroke through experiential throughout the workshop
- Explore the effects of bladder and bowel issues post stroke and its management.
