Join us to learn about the new TBP (Transmission Based Precautions) guidance which was published on the 3rd August 2026 and the resources available to support implementation within care home settings. The session will explain the evidence and rationale behind the changes, provide an overview of the guidance development methodology, and highlight what has changed within the Care Home IPC Manual, [Care Home Infection Prevention and Control Manual \(CHIPCM\)](#) including any new requirements for practice.

The webinar will include:

- **Why guidance has changed** and the evidence that informed the review and update.
- **How guidance was developed**, including the methodology used to ensure recommendations are evidence-based and fit for practice.
- An **overview of the key changes** within the Care Home IPC Manual and the implications for care homes.
- The range of **educational and implementation resources** available to support staff and organisations.
- **Applying guidance in practice**, using realistic care home scenarios to demonstrate how the recommendations can be implemented in day-to-day care.

The webinar forms part of the ARHAI Scotland Care Home IPC Programme and is delivered with support from a multi-agency Webinar Short Life Working Group (SLWG) responsible for content development, planning and delivery.
