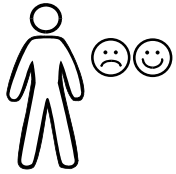


## What will happen at my appointment?



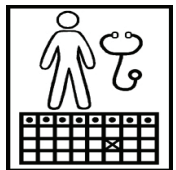
The doctor will take you to a private consulting room and will:



- ♦ ask you about the problems you have been having. You will have lots of time to talk to the doctor so the doctor can try to understand your problems



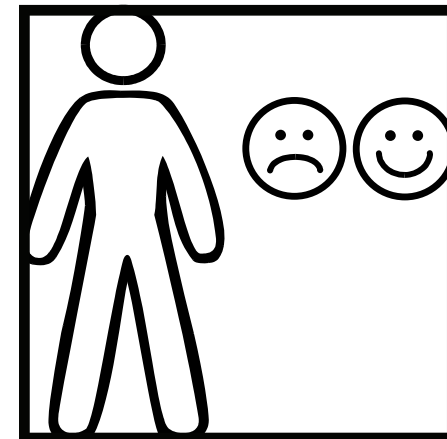
- ♦ discuss different treatment choices with you and help you decide which would be the best for you



- ♦ you may be asked to come back at another time.

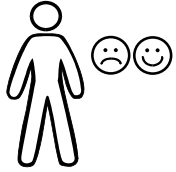

## What is the Psychiatry Clinic?



You can see a specialist doctor who can assess the problems you've been having recently.



**If you need help or a wheelchair, please phone us before you come. Our phone number is on your appointment letter. Please try to arrive on time.**

## What should I do when I get there?



When you arrive, go to the reception desk. Hand in your appointment card or give your name.



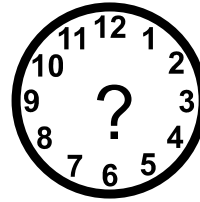
The receptionist will ask you to sit in the waiting area. Someone from the clinic will call your name when it's your turn to be seen.

## What should I do if I cannot come?



If you cannot come to your appointment please phone the number on your appointment letter or e-mail the address on your appointment letter.

## How long will my appointment take?



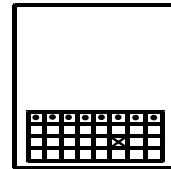
You should allow about 1 hour for your appointment. When the clinic is very busy you may have to wait.

We will tell you how long you have to wait.

We will give you another appointment time if you cannot wait.

## What should I bring to the appointment?

- ♦ your appointment card



- ♦ a list of your medicines



- ♦ a list of questions you might want to ask.
