By Car

If you are coming to the site by care and using a sat nav the address is:

If you do not have a sat nav from the City of Edinburgh Bypass you should exit at the Lothianburn Junction, which is opposite the ski slope.

Directions will say A702 Carlisle, Biggar, City Centre. At the top of the off ramp turn towards City Centre. Go up the hill to the traffic lights. Go straight over the lights and follow the road down the hill. Keep following this road and you will reach a busy area with shops on both sides, there are traffic lights all along this road. Keep straight on.

As the road begins to go uphill you will see a Waitrose store on the right on a corner.

Take the next again right (Newbattle Terrace) and you will go past a cinema on your right.

Carry on along this road, which becomes quite narrow. You will see large iron gates on your right about 1/4 mile along opposite a wide road to the left.

Go past these gates and as the road bends slightly to the right (there are high walls on both sides) there is another set of gates on the right which are open.

Turn right through the gate and then immediately turn sharp right.

We are the stone building beside the gate.
