



## ECSS Aims

• To provide a service where people can access multidisciplinary team support and rehabilitation in the community following a stroke.

• To provide continued stroke specific rehabilitation within the community based on individual rehabilitation need and goals.

## The ECSS Team

• ECSS is a multidisciplinary service
provided by:

Occupational Therapists,

Physiotherapists, an Employment and Training advisor and Community Support Workers.

ECSS is an integrated service (NHS and City of Edinburgh Council) and we share your relevant medical/social information within the team. Information is shared on a need to know basis and is kept within Data Protection legislative guidelines.

• The service has close links to other agencies including

Speech and Language Therapists, Assistive Technology Occupational Therapist, Chest Heart & Stroke Scotland Nurses, Consultant in rehabilitative medicine (community) Neuropsychology, Grapevine (welfare checking service), and other statutory/voluntary services.

## What ECSS Provides

• ECSS can provide rehabilitation input once a week. This can be either Community and/or Centre based.

• ECSS is a flexible, personalised service providing 1:1 input or group work as appropriate incorporating Health promotion and selfmanagement strategies. The duration of ECSS input is time limited depending on individual rehabilitation need and goals.

• Door-to-door transport may be available if independent travel is not possible.

• If required, individuals can obtain support with personal care within the ECSS centre, but ECSS cannot directly organise home care packages.
