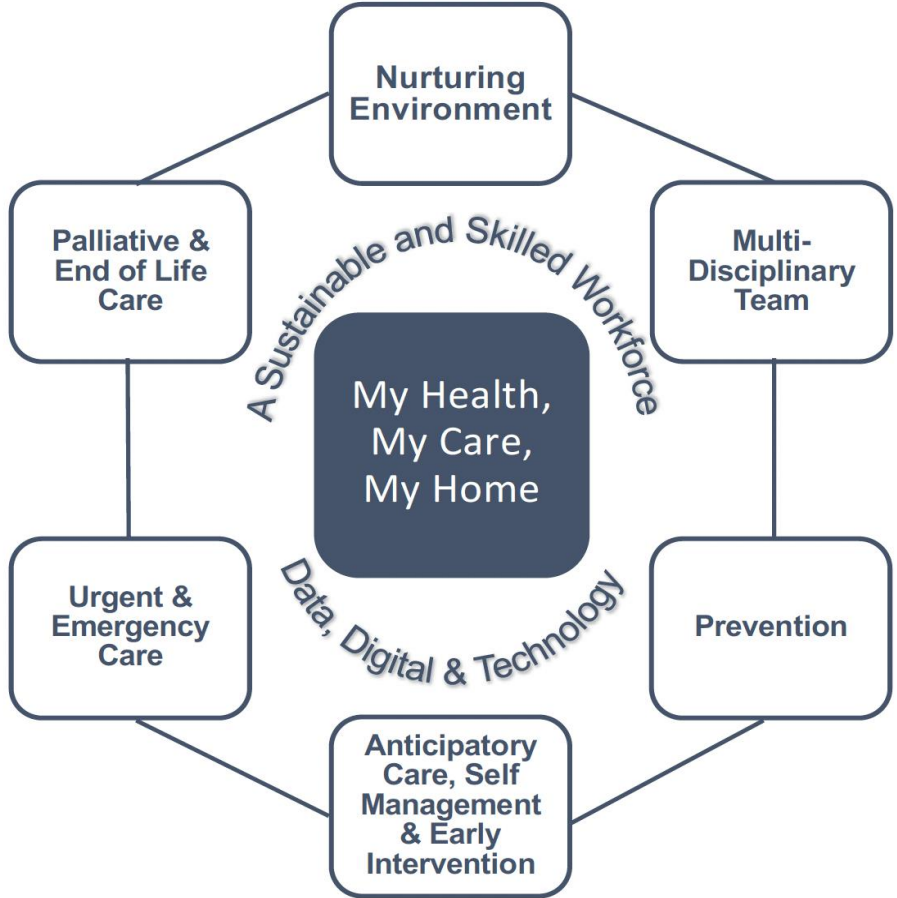

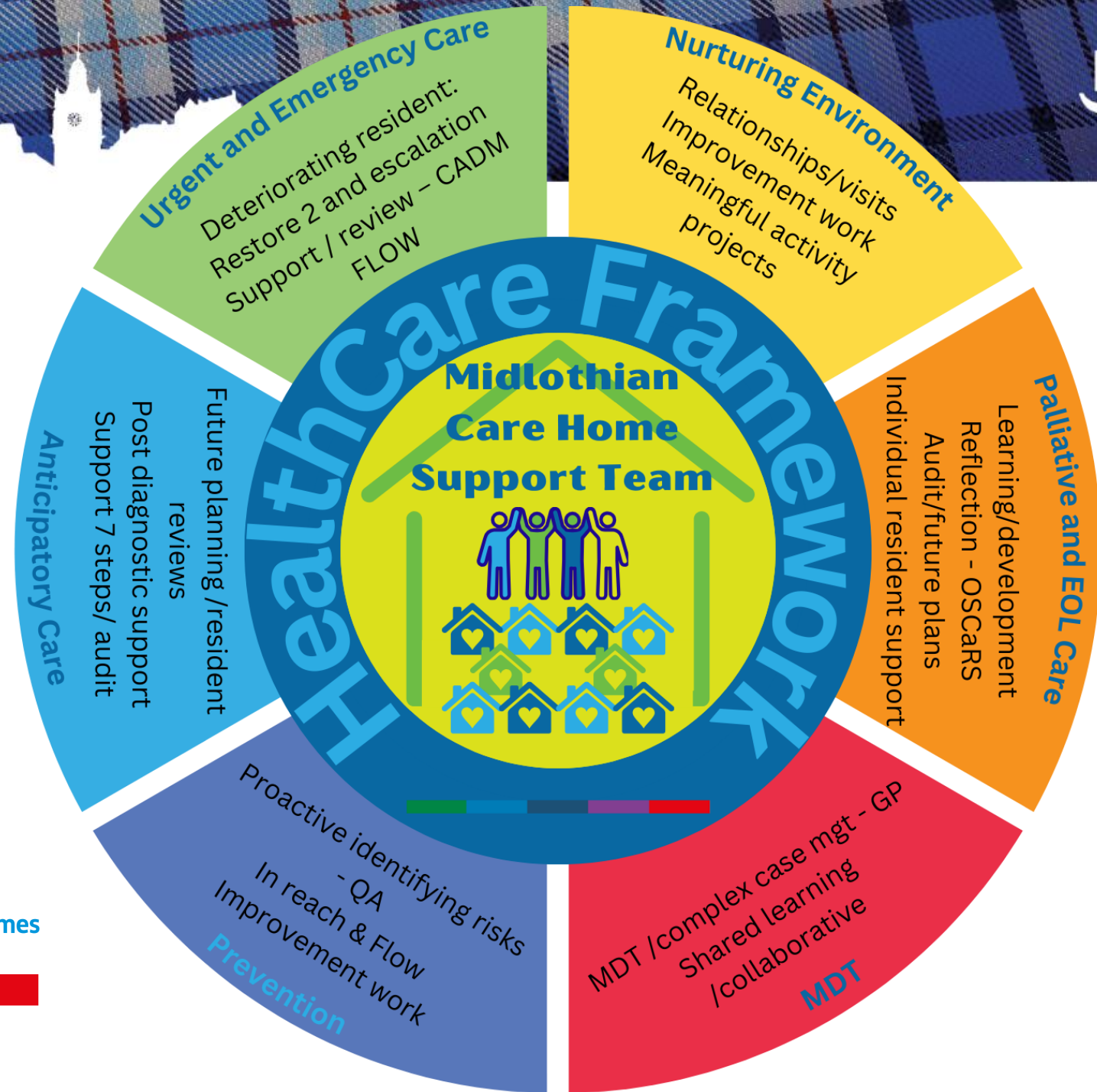
- **CHST provide clinical Nursing care in residential homes across the City in collaboration with the District Nursing service.**
