How to download and start using the Home Care Decisions app

- Go to the apps store on your phone and search for **Home Care Decisions** and **l**ook for the logo
- Tap on Install. When it has installed, tap on Open
- When you first download the app, you will see a list of available toolkits. Click on the first toolkit to download it.
- To download another toolkit **click on the 5 horizontal lines** at the top right of any app page and then **click on the green cloud** bottom right of this new panel
- Once you have downloaded all your toolkits you can move between them by clicking on the

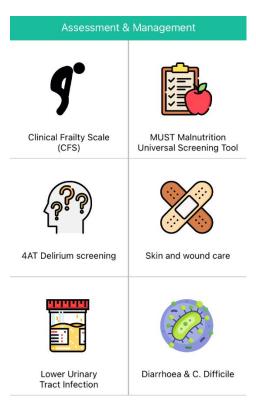

The **Assessment and Management** Toolkit

Guidance to help care workers to make their own decisions where appropriate and to communicate key information to the wider multi-professional team.

It includes the Clinical Frailty Scale, 4-AT tool for delirium screening, guidance on UTI symptoms, and wound assessment, the MUST tool for malnutrition screening (due November 2021) and others.

Topics have appropriate use information and contain links to further content and functionality.

The Palliative and End of Life Care Toolkit

Practical guidance on caring for people with palliative and end of life care needs- physical, emotional and spiritual.

This part of the app has been created in collaboration with Macmillan Cancer Support.
