Our treatment packages are fully inclusive of all appointments, tests, scans, medications, and laboratory practices required. There are no additional charges to complete a treatment cycle.

Refund policy

Occasionally treatment cycles are cancelled due to a variety of reasons. From the time you accept a date for your initial pre-treatment scan, you are financially committed to the cost of the IVF cycle. Payment must be made prior to the commencement of treatment. If you decide to cancel after treatment has commenced, no refund will be provided.

If you proceed to egg recovery and no egg is retrieved, no eggs fertilise normally or there is no embryo suitable to transfer, you will not be entitled to a refund. If you are self-funding your treatment, it is important to consider the financial as well as emotional implication(s) of treatment prior to booking your treatment.

On occasions you may be advised to discontinue treatment due to e.g., poor, or excessive response to the treatment drugs, or a co-incidental development of some other condition during treatment. If this occurs a partial refund as outlined below may be offered.

If EFC makes a clinical decision to freeze all your embryos in an IVF or ICSI cycle, your first frozen embryo transfer and associated HRT medication (if required) will be free of charge. Please be aware that there will be no refund associated with the fresh cycle.

All refunds will be processed after the clinical team have reviewed your medical record. In the event of an unexpected interruption to our services which is out with our control, your treatment may have to be cancelled. In this case you will be entitled to a full refund.

Refunds

Cancelled IVF / ICSI cycle due to poor response or potential ovarian hyperstimulation syndrome* £2,800 refund

* If cancellation is due to potential ovarian hyperstimulation syndrome, there is an option to transfer funding to next treatment cycle.

Cancelled FET – no embryo transfer (failed thaw) £500 refund

Second cycle of sibling intra-uterine insemination (IUI) with donor sperm if not required £800 refund

Refunds for other treatments will be calculated accordingly.

Non-refundable deposits

This is relevant to you if you chose to cancel treatment before you have started stimulation injections or received monitoring (blood tests or scans) by the clinic. This non-refundable deposit is to cover costs incurred by EFC before you cancelled your treatment. £500

Payments

Payments for an initial consultation, semen analysis, AMH and ultrasound scans and frozen embryo transfer, IUI are payable at the time of booking. Your appointment will be cancelled if payment has not been made 14 days after invoice has been sent.

First cycle of treatment – before you start your treatment, you will need to attend a nurse discussion. payment for the treatment is due prior to this appointment.

Subsequent cycles of treatment – payment must be made at time of arranging your cycle and treatment cannot progress until this time.

Payment methods

In person

Payment can be made in person by credit or debit card or by cash at the Cashier's Office within The Royal Infirmary of Edinburgh, Little France Crescent, Edinburgh, EH16 4SA. The Cashier's Office is located within the main mall of the hospital. Please quote your fertility number when making payment.

Telephone

Payment can be made via telephone by credit or debit card. This can be done by phoning the Cashier's Office at The Royal Infirmary of Edinburgh on **0131 242 2323**. Please quote your fertility number when making payment.

Online

Please note – if you chose to pay online, you are required to bring a copy of your payment confirmation at your pre-doctor's appointment. Failure to provide this may result in your treatment being postponed.
